Planning and management are disciplines sometimes collaborating yet more often only juxtaposing. This happens due to the **different orientation** (the former more public, the latter more private) **as well as for what concerns the temporal perspective** (the former on the 'long run', the latter on the 'short run'). In the last decades, the overlooking of planning in favor of management approaches has demonstrated to be unable to deal with the global crises affecting our societies and built environments (climatic, demographic, development models, etc.). A better integration of the two disciplines is urgently needed, if not avoid at least to decipher and effectively tackle these crises.

The Workshop, held at the DPIA Department of the University of Udine, **aims to discuss the role of both disciplines by focusing on their limits and virtues** while addressing as specific reference and field of action the city and territory.

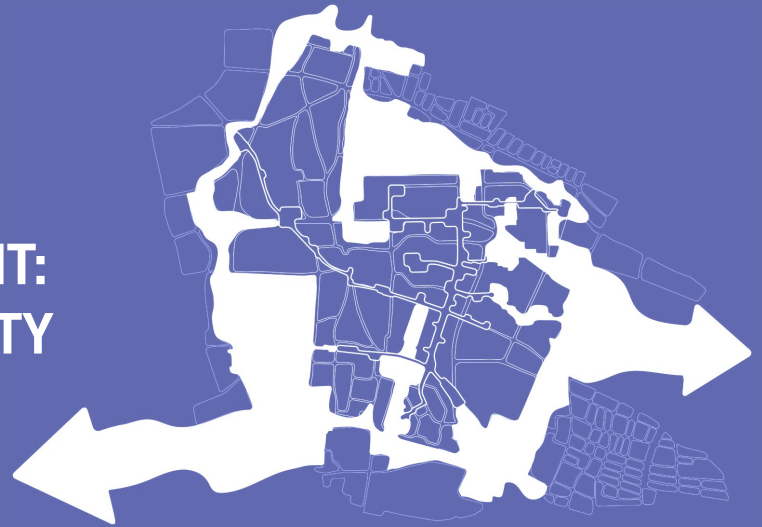
